New Leadership Coming for Auxiliaries

Auxiliary Elections Set for Saturday, July 12

The State Congress of Christian Education, the State Laymen's League and the State Ushers will see a changing of the guard on Saturday, July 12, 2014. The groups will meet in Raleigh at First Cosmopolitan Baptist Church (1515 Cross Link Road, Raleigh). New officers will be elected in each auxiliary for a four-year term, 2014-2018.

Reverend Theodore Breeden is chairman of the 2014 GBSC Election Committee and is in charge of conducting the elections on July 12. Persons who are interested in an elected position are listed on Page 2 of the *Baptist Bulletin*. An opportunity to make nominations from the floor will be provided by the Election Committee before the voting begins for each auxiliary.

NOTICE

In order to vote in the Auxiliary elections on July 12, you must be an official DELEGATE from your Church. Every church is entitled to send a number of delegates based on the size of the Church membership.

Each Church is required to pay the necessary registration fee for EACH election for which the Church is sending delegates. For example, if a Church is sending delegates for the Congress and the Laymen elections, the Church must register for both auxiliaries.

NO VOTING BADGES WILL BE ISSUED FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE NOT OFFICIAL DELEGATES FROM THEIR CHURCHES.

Churches wishing to pre-register may do so by delivering the proper form and fees to Baptist Headquarters by Friday, July 11 at noon. Churches may also register on site beginning at 8:30 a.m. on July 12 at First Cosmopolitan Baptist Church (1515 Cross Link Road, Raleigh, NC).
